### Use your Workflow for instant feedback

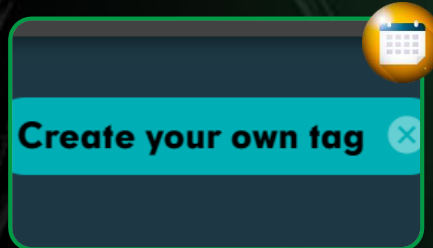
Feed back to your team instantly using your Workflow. This is designed to provide timely and informal feedback, without using judgements.

### Create your own Gallery tags

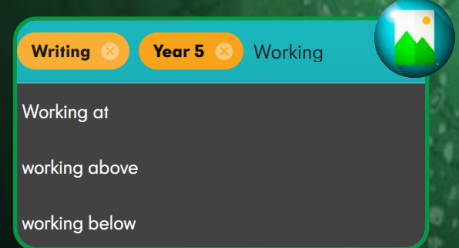
When you take a photo, you can tag and annotate it. Create tags of your own to help staff to quickly search and find specific content in your Gallery.

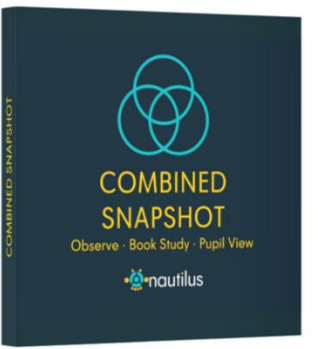
## The Nautilus Community

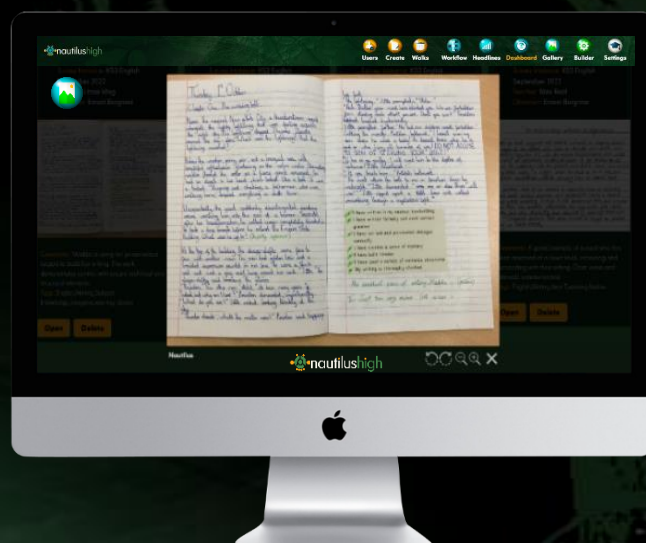




## A New Adventure

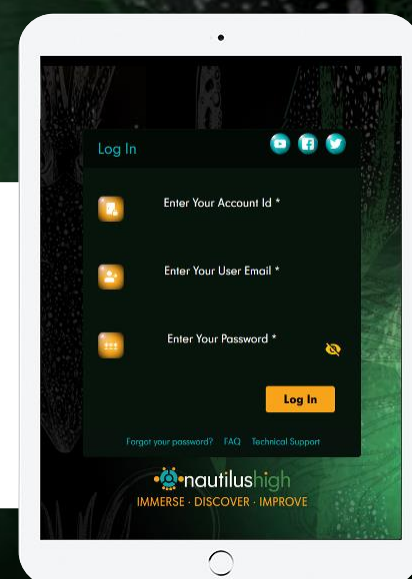
New frameworks, same great features

With subject specific dashboard analysis to quickly identify strengths and areas for improvement. The Workflow can then help you to create supportive professional dialogue between subject specialists.

We’ve also added frameworks that can offer efficient teaching and learning evaluations, plus a selection that will focus heavily on pastoral care. This enables leaders to capture the learning in the classrooms, as well as pupil views around transition, safety and enjoyment.

As with the primary platform, users can clone, edit and create content in minutes. This enables leaders to transfer any existing observation proformas to the system, so that they can begin to build data sets for analysis.
